FROM SAN LUIS OBISPO,CA: Stay straight to go onto US-101 S/El Camino Real S. Continue to follow US-101 S. Then 50.78 miles Take the CA-246 exit, EXIT 140A, toward Solvang/Lompoc. Then in 0.18 miles turn right onto E Highway 246/CA-246. Continue to follow CA-246. Then in 0.19 miles take the 1st left onto Avenue of the Flags.
