The 98th FMCA Convention held in Gillette, Wyoming, is now history and all who attended had a great time. There were 1,578 family units and 217 display coaches for a grand total of 1,735. It did rain a couple of times but had little effect on the fun.

The following is the Governing Board Activity Report:

The Governing Board concluded their meeting with the following decisions.

Constitution and Bylaws Amendment Proposals

Proposal 1: The purpose is to provide flexibility in providing refunds: Passed

Proposal 2: To authorize electronic voting by the Executive and Governing Boards: Passed.

Proposal 3: Duplicate of #2 (this was submitted by written petition): Failed

Proposal 4: Provide definition of recreational vehicle: Passed

Proposal 5: Provides Commercial Member flexibility: Passed

Proposal 6: Adds flexibility to refund dues: Passed

Proposal 7: Revises the governing board by creating Area National Directors rather than chapter directors in an effort to represent all of FMCA's members: Failed

Proposal 8: this was a "Proviso" and would affect numerous Polices and Procedures if Proposal #7 passed: Failed (because #7 failed)

Policy and Procedure Amendment Proposals

("Proviso"... is defined as a condition attached to an agreement)

P&P #1001: Proviso if Bylaw Amendment #2 was approved: Passed

P&P #1015: Proviso if Bylaw Amendments #4 & #6 were approved: Passed

P&P #1017: Proviso if Bylaw amendment #5 was approved: Passed

P&P #2031: Proposal split into two sections. #1: Executive Board members may travel to other Area rallies with consent of the National President: Passed. #2: eliminates per diem and creates "meal expenses": Passed

Clerical changes were made to about 40 P&P's



Southern Area Vice President's Message




Hello to all WMHA Chapters and especially the Chapters of the Southern region.

Positions available at Indio:

We need someone to take the <u>captain position for the Decorating Crew</u>. This is a very fun position and Sandy King is willing to help with the transition.

We are in immediate need of an <u>assistant Seminar Captain</u> for Indio. For the 2019 rally the assistant, working with the seminar captain will be responsible for: craft scheduling & sign-ups, seminar monitors/evaluators and also take care of after-hours building scheduling (for chapter parties, events, etc). The current captain will still do the seminar scheduling. Starting in 2020 the assistant will become the new captain and take over all seminar/building scheduling along with an assistant of their choice.

We are also in need of someone to take over putting together the Rally Program Book and the Rally At A Glance guide. The current program manager will work with the new person this year with the new person taking over for 2020.

We are in immediate need of a <u>Day Pass Captain</u>. Day pass captain is responsible for having passes printed for the four day sales time frame of the rally and ensuring support supplies are adequate (radios, carts, pass holders, water, etc). Also ensure you have volunteers to man the gates, normally two per shift and you are responsible for daily accounting of money collected. You will have the current assistant captain working with you and the outgoing captain will assist as much as possible.
