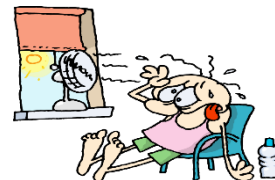


## From our Hospitality Desk

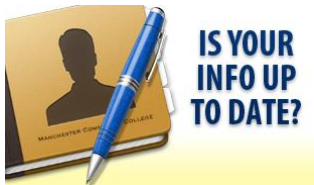

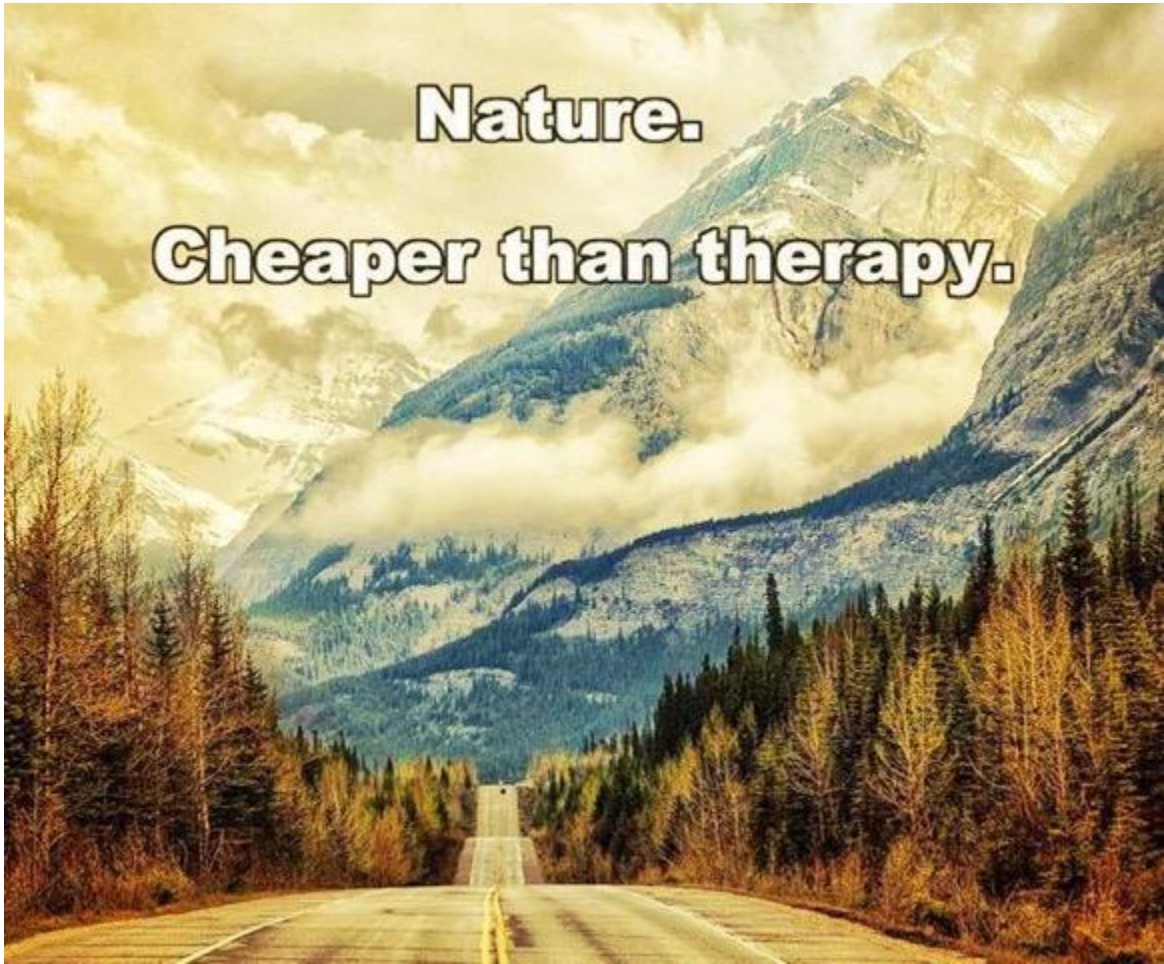
