Ramblers. Happy Hour with heavy appetizers made for a good dinner!

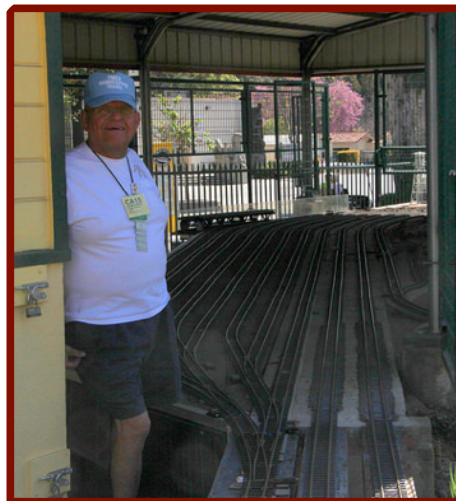
