THINGS TO DO AND SEE IN BUELLTON AND SOLVANG

SOLVANG

Solvang is a city in southern California's Santa Ynez Valley. It's known for its Danish-style architecture and many wineries. Solvang is Danish for 'sunny field It is located in the Santa Ynez Valley. The population was 5,245 at the 2010 census, down from 5,332 at the 2000 census. Solvang was incorporated as a city on May 1, 1985.



MISSION SANTA INES

Mission Santa Inés is a Spanish mission in the present-day city of Solvang, California, and named after St. Agnes of Rome The museum, church and garden are open daily for tours that begin in the Mission gift shop. Self-guided tour hours are 9:00 AM - 4:30 PM daily (except Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years Day) Price: \$5.00 (Children under 12 - free admission to the museum).

The mission site was chosen as a midway point between
Mission Santa Barbara and Mission La Purísima Concepción,
and was designed to relieve overcrowding at those two missions and to serve the Indians
living east of the Coast Range



THE HANS CHRISTIAN ANDERSEN MUSEUM

The Hans Christian Andersen Museum is operated by the Ugly Duckling Foundation, a non profit organization established to foster public understanding and enjoyment of Hans Christian Andersen and his work.

The Museum is located upstairs in The Book Loft Building 1680 Mission Drive in Solvang. Open Daily from 10:00 am to 5:00 PM.



NOJOQUI FALLS

Nojoqui Falls is 1 &1/2 miles east of Highway 101 near Gaviota Pass. From Highway 101, take the Old Coast Road to Alisal Road; from Solvang, follow Alisal Road south to the park





Take Highway 246 east out of Solvang about 3.3 miles

Offers several restaurants including a Food Court, all-you-can-eat buffet, and the Four Diamond rated Willows.
