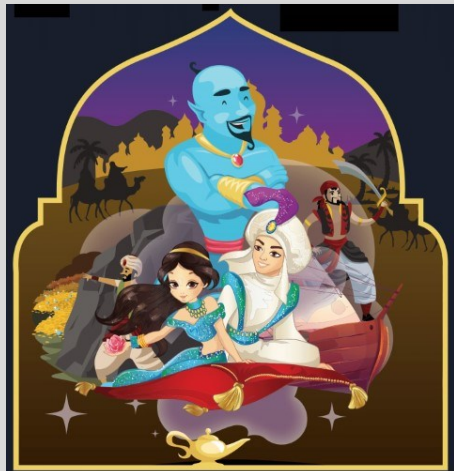

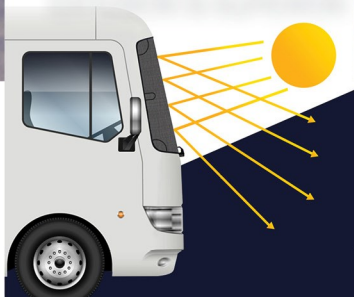

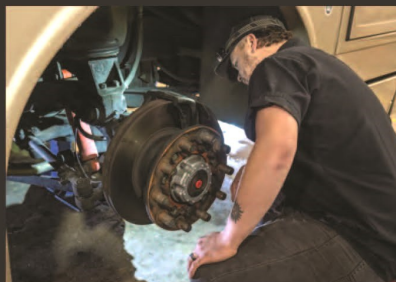

Operating hours are 7:00 am to 10:00 pm for those not parked in the electric area. A Full Generator Area is available for those needing generator power 24 hours/day
