President's Message



Jan and I traveled to Indianapolis, IN for the Family Reunion and Motor Home Show. Members of the Executive Board, as I did. and other volunteers laid out the lots and parked all of the member vehicles. There were approximately 2800 counting vendor live-ins and display coaches. I represented the Beat The Odds Chapter at the Governing Board meeting as a

Temporary Delegate. By now you probably know what was decided about the main issues. The admittance of towables as FMCA members was denied. They may attend rallies, and are invited, but may not belong. FMCA can no longer afford to provide free medical evacuation without some financial change. Raising dues was considered, but making it a purchased benefit was elected. The new FMCAssist is provided by Seven Corners which is underwritten by Lords of London and is much better than the previous plan. Costs are \$85 per individual, \$105. per family per year. We signed-up 10/1/12. Members not signing-up may use all of the services under the plan but must pay for each service. One other major item was the deletion of the P & P that provided stipends to various team captains, parkers. etc. FMCA intends to be an all volunteer organization at Family Reunions just as are Area rallies.

From Indianapolis we traveled to Gillette, WY. for the Rocky Mountain Ramble. Gillette is the site of next year's FMCA 50th anniversary celebration. All of the RMMA staff treated us royally and are extremely gracious. I'd name names and surely would forget some, so I won't. Harry Montgomery decided to be my mentor and dragged me all over the complex , to my benefit. Gillette is a relatively small town but has some very fine restaurants. One oddity is a huge parking lot holding a Wal-Mart and a Kmart next to each other. I've heard the reservation forms for the 50th at Gillette will be


